Each of our walks starts and ends near a bus stop. The main walking trail is waymarked at significant turning points.

A cycling route around the harbour, and a series of circular walks, are described on our website.



New walk for 2024 - the Cordite Way, Phase 1 footpath, is open for a walk to Poole Harbour viewpoints from the Walk 5b start point. Volunteers welcome to help develop the Cordite Way further.

OUR WALKS

Our routes are easy to walk with very few stiles and only a few gentle climbs.

- WALK 1** Poole Quay to Greenlands. 12 km
Poole, the ferry and some forgotten beaches. 7.5 mls
- WALK 2** Greenlands to Purbeck Park. 11 km
Heath, woods and a medieval packhorse bridge. 7 mls
- WALK 3** Purbeck Park to Wareham. 12 km
Heath, woods, a 19th century plateway and a river. 7.5 mls
- WALK 4** Wareham Quay to Sandford. 12 km
Rivers and Wareham Forest. 7.5 mls
- WALK 5a** Sandford to Turlin Moor. 13.5 km
Our latest walk, a temporary completion of the circuit while we develop a route nearer the harbour. 8.5 mls
- WALK 6** Turlin Moor to Poole Quay. 11 km
Heaths, beaches and urban walking at its best. 7 mls

POOLE HARBOUR



Poole Harbour is near the centre of the south coast of England in the county of Dorset. Regular trains between London Waterloo and Weymouth serve Parkstone, Poole, Hamworthy, Holton Heath and Wareham stations. These, together with Norden station or buses, provide access to the harbour trails.

The six walks and cycling trail around the harbour are marked on Ordnance Survey maps. Our circular walks visit nearby places of interest, such as Upton Country Park, Poole Park, Purbeck, Wareham Forest, Holes Bay and the nature reserves at Upton and Lytchett Bay.

A new harbour walk is under development between Sandford, Holton Heath and Rockley Jetty. Known as the Cordite Way, this includes a recently-designated footpath that provides a short woodland walk with scenic views of Poole Harbour and Purbeck.
