







Our six linear walks can be downloaded from

OUR WALKS

Our routes are easy to walk with very few stiles and only a few gentle climbs.

WALK 1 Poole Quay to Greenlands.
Poole, the ferry and some forgotten beaches.

12 km
7.5 mls

WALK 2 Greenlands to Norden Park-and-Ride. Heath, woods and a medieval packhorse bridge.

11 km

WALK 3 Norden Park-and-Ride to Wareham. Heath, woods, a 19th century plateway and a river.

WALK 4 Wareham Quay to Sandford. Rivers and Wareham Forest.

WALK 5b Sandford to Turlin Moor. Our latest walk, a temporary completion of the circuit while we wait for a route nearer the harbour.
